(NB: We do not usually contract nouns and **will** in writing.)
4. We **will not be starting** the new project next Monday morning. / We **won't be starting** the new project next Monday morning.
5. This Saturday night, Ethan and I **will not be staying** at home. / This Saturday night, Ethan and I **won't be staying** at home.
6. This time next year, I **will be living** in a different city. / This time next year, I'll **be living** in a different city.
7. They **will not be driving** to work tomorrow. / They **won't be driving** to work tomorrow.
8. Who **will** they **be meeting** after school?
9. **Will** he **be flying** to Mexico next week?
