Answers

A.

1. I **will finish** my homework tonight. / I'll **finish** my homework tonight.
2. She **will not attend** the meeting. / She **won't attend** the meeting.
3. The dog **will be** tired after our walk.
(NB: We don't usually contract nouns and **will** in writing.)
4. He **will not forget** your birthday. / He **won't forget** your birthday.
5. The students **will arrive** in half an hour.
(See A.2.)
6. Charlotte **will not help** her aunt. / Charlotte **won't help** her aunt.
7. Ethel and I **will drive** you to the station.
(NB: The contraction of "I will" is "I'll", but we don't usually contract it in writing if it's with another noun, so we don't usually write "Ethel and I'll drive".)
8. I don't think Jane and Liam **will enjoy** the concert.
(See A.2.)
9. The birds **will fly** south in the winter.
(See A.2.)
10. We **will not buy** new phones this year. / We **won't buy** new phones this year.
